

DUKE HIGHWAY

THE EMPLOYEES PROVIDENT FUND (EPF) BOARD BOUGHT A 40% STAKE IN KONSORTIUM LEBUHRAYA UTARA-TIMUR (KL) SDN BHD (KESTURI), FOR RM1.13BIL CASH. KESTURI, WHICH IS THE CONCESSION HOLDER OF THE DUTA-ULU KELANG EXPRESSWAY ("DUKE"), A 34-KILOMETRE HIGHWAY COMPRISING TWO PHASES.

Duke phase 1 is already in operation while phase 2 is expecting to complete construction and commence toll collection by the first half of 2017. Upon completion of the construction for duke phase 2, the traffic volume for duke is expected to double.

The 18km DUKE highway started operations in April 2009. Formerly known as the Kuala Lumpur North East Expressway (KLNEE), the expressway was a prominent element in the Kuala Lumpur Road Master Plan as highlighted in the Japan International Corporation Agency (JICA) Transport Study which was carried out for the Dewan Bandaraya Kuala Lumpur (DBKL) in 1985. Earmarked by DBKL as one of the key links to complete the Kuala Lumpur Master Traffic Dispersal Plan,

KESTURI had carried out a detailed study on the alignment spanning three years including an Environmental Impact Assessment and Public Opinion Survey. Both these studies and reports were approved before the Concession Agreement was signed with the Malaysian Government on 12th August 2004.

The Expressway was officially launched by the Works Minister, Yang Berhormat Dato Mohd Zin Mohamed, on 9 January 2009.. Designed to cater for 120,000 vehicles per day, the Expressway will offer an attracitve alternative route for residents in the Klang Valley, especially for those travelling from east to west and vice versa and for those heading towards the city centre.

The DUKE Phase 2 comprising of two links, namely the Sri Damansara Link and the Tun Razak Link and is expected to be completed by mid 2017 and the toll concession runs until 2059, subject to another extension by 10 years. The Sri Damansara Link connects MRR2 and DUKE and helps to disperse traffic to and from MRR2 to city centre. The Tun Razak Link will act as an additional dispersal link between DUKE and MRR1 thus providing an additional dispersal option for the congested Jalan Tun Razak.

Speaking after the signing ceremony between Kesturi and EPF held at the Sheraton Imperial Hotel, Kuala Lumpur on the 8 November 2016, Ekovest Berhad Executive Chairman Tan Sri Dato' Lim Kang Hoo said, "The Proposed Disposal is in line with the Company's strategy to monetise its matured infrastructure assets to free up its financial resources for the expansion of its infrastructure division and other core businesses, such as construction and property development. It represents an opportunity for the Company to partially monetise its investment in Kesturi at an attractive price, while allowing Ekovest to continue participating in Kesturi and operate the highway via its remaining 60% equity stake. It is estimated to result in a balance sheet gain on disposal of RM764 million which will further strengthen Ekovest's shareholders funds.

Managing director Datuk Seri Lim Keng Cheng said the group was upbeat on its partnership with EPF."EPF sees us as a connector because of the Duta-Ulu Kelang Expressway (Duke) project, which will link roads and highways in the Kuala Lumpur city. We want to be market leaders. With Duke, we are the highway connectors and the missing link. With capital coming in, I will propose more highways but I won't overstress my company financially. Because our infrastructure division grew so big, we decided that we should divest the 40 per cent to EPF. The relationship with EPF is very good as they trust us," said Lim. He further acknowledged that Ekovest was set to remain a strong player in the construction sector, backed by a solid track record and confidence brought on by investments from EPF.

# TOP ASIA AWARD FOR SUKUK ISSUANCE

The RM3.64 Billion (US\$818m) project financing that featured a new shariah-compliant structure, set a record for the largest Malaysian ringgit bond for a greenfield toll-road project. Lebuhraya DUKE Fasa 3 Sdn Bhd, as the Issuer, raised the funds in August to help fund the construction of the Setiawangsa-Pantai Expressway (formerly known as the DUKE Phase 3), a 32.1km elevated expressway that will complete a critical ring road around Kuala Lumpur.

AmInvestment Bank, acting as the financial and principal adviser, proposed a Wakalah Bi al-Istithmar structure, combining the Wakalah, Murabahah and Tawarrug principles in a format that is asset-light.

Most sukuk structures require physical underlying assets, but the Sukuk Wakalah caters to DUKE 3's lack of tangible assets and allowed the Issuer to enter the bond market at the greenfield stage, a first of its kind for a greenfield toll project in Malaysia. Under the Wakalah Bi al-Istithmar structure, an investment wakeel or agent, such as a financial institution, will invest the proceeds in a combination of assets and debt. This comprise of the Duke 3's 53-year operating concession and its construction activities, a commodity Murabahah investment and the Tawarruq, a tripartite sale format as the platform.





Malaysian investors welcomed the new structure and local rating agency MARC assigned an AA- rating. The debt is also supported by a RM560 Million interest-free reimbursable interest assistance loan from the Federal Government of Malaysia, the first facility of its kind for a greenfield project. Ekovest's M\$850m equity injection made up the balance.

As the project is now entering its final phase of completion, a lot of finishing and landscaping works can be seen at site, making its progress towards the end of the construction period.

Trees, shrubs and turfed lawn have been planted as accordance to their required locations, local and imported floor finishes have been installed and paved along the walk-way whereas a number of landscape furniture have been constructed at site. As of to-date, the progress now tallies 92% and the project is going to be completed by April 15, 2017.

During VISITATION DAY, the PM ARRIVED at Masjid Jamek Node at around 5.00pm. The project which is known as ROL River Beautification Package 4A & 4B covers the following locations:-

- Package 4A Sungai Klang from Jalan Kinabalu to Jalan Maarof;
- Package 4B Brickfields areas: Jalan Scott, Jalan Tun Sambathan 4, Jalan Thambipillay, Jalan Sultan Abdul Samad, Jalan Vivekananda, Jalan Rozario, Jalan Chan Ah Tong, Jalan Ah Tong, Jalan Tebing.

Similar to the works in Precinct 7, interceptor system along Sungai Klang will also be built to treat the sullage water before it flows to the river

The jobs which are amounted to RM 255.49 million, are targeted to be completed with the construction period of 130 weeks. As of to-date, the progress at site was at 1.53%. At this juncture, most of the preliminary works have been conducted at site.

The trust of the Government on Ekovest to undertake another ROL River Beautification Phase 2 work package was denoted when the Government on 4th November 2016, issued Letter of Acceptance of Tender to EKORIVER CONSTRUCTION SDN.BHD. (a wholly owned-subsidiary of Ekovest Berhad) to carry out river beautification and interceptor works under ROL River Beautification Package 1C and 1D. The beautification works under this contract, cover the following locations:-

- Package 1C Dataran Merdeka and Jalan Tun Perak until Jalan Tun Tan Cheng Lock
- Package 1D Masjid India

Under the above contract as well, a number of treatment plants for interceptor system will also be built at Jalan Melayu, near the LRT Masjid Jamek Station, to improve the water quality for Sungai Klang.

The Government agreed for Ekovest to execute the above works at a total cost of RM 157.25 million and it shall be completed in 104 weeks construction period. As of to-date, the status of the project was at 2.37% progress.




